# Medicare Open Enrollment ends December 7

Medicare Open Enrollment, also known as the Annual Enrollment Period, or AEP, takes place from **October 15 to December 7, 2023**. During this time, you can update your plan to better suit your health needs and budget for the following year. These changes will go into effect on **January 1, 2024**.

# What changes can I make during Open Enrollment?

During the Medicare Open Enrollment period, if you are already enrolled in Medicare coverage, you have several choices:

- Change or enroll in Medicare Advantage Plans (Part C)
- Change Prescription Drug Plans (Part D)
- Return to Original Medicare

## Why should I review my coverage?

Are your combined Medicare Supplement and Prescription Drug Plan premiums over \$200 per month? Have you had a major life event such as divorce, bankruptucy, loss of a spouse or recently moved to a new area? Have you experienced a significant health event in the last 12 months? If so, you should review your options.

#### Review your Annual Notice of Change (ANOC)
